- 1) Grocery Tax Relief (H0588): Sponsor: Rep. Clifford Bayer (R-21): Increased the Grocery Tax credit for all Idaho families. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed 27-8.
- 2) Merit Pay for Teachers (S1436): Sponsor: Sen. Russ Fulcher (R-21): Merit pay program for teachers. Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Failed 16-19.
- 3) Providing Voters with Fiscal Impact Statements on Proposed Ballot Initiatives (S1484) Sponsor: Sen. Monty Pearce (R-9) Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed: 23-9

- 4) Abortion Information (H0559): Requires that informed consent material be made available to women considering an abortion on a secure website and that abortion practitioners and their agents provide the address to women considering an abortion. Sponsor: Rep. Lynn Luker (R-15). Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed 29-6
- 5) Abortion Coercion (H0654): Makes it a crime to physically coerce or threaten to physically coerce a woman to have an abortion. Sponsor: Rep. Bob Nonini (R-5) Idaho Conservative Position: Yes. Passed: 29-6
